1 Whereas the parties have entered into a settlement agreement of all class claims, including
2 Counts 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the First Amended Complaint (“FAC”) (the “Settlement Agreement”) and
3 neither party admitted any liability;

4 Whereas the Parties have agreed that the Settlement Administrator shall cause the Net
5 Settlement Payments, service award to Named Plaintiff, Attorneys’ fees and costs, and PAGA
6 Settlement to be paid within eighteen (18) days after the later of: (1) the date that Judgment and an
7 Order by the Court granting final approval of this Settlement become non-appealable, or (2) to the
8 extent any appeals have been filed, they have been resolved or exhausted.

9 The Court HEREBY ORDERS:

10 1. The Court enters final judgment on the class action claims and PAGA claims
11 asserted in Counts 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the FAC in accordance with the terms of the Settlement
12 Agreement, its March 16, 2017 Order Granting Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement,
13 its May 1, 2017 Order Amending the Preliminary Approval Order, and its Order Granting Final
14 Approval of Class Action Settlement.

15 2. The Court finds that the class includes all massage therapists, estheticians,
16 cosmetologists and nail technicians who worked for MG Temecula, Inc.; X-Treme Green One, Inc.,
17 MG Carlsbad, Inc.; MG Chino, Inc.; MG Stressless, Inc.; MG Riverside, Inc.; MG Orange Crest,
18 Inc.; or MG Temecula Two, Inc. and were paid on a piece-rate basis on any day from February 9,
19 2011 to October 13, 2014.

20 3. Excluded from the class are the following sixteen individuals whose Class Notice
21 was deemed undeliverable by the Settlement Administrator: Teresita Baladad, Sunny
22 Chamruangrar, Juan Chen, Martha Chewa, Danielle Fanello, Erica M Figueroa, Dora A Guadamuz,
23 Shantell Johnson, Jared J Lojeske, Monique Marsh, Heaven M Rigdon, Cher Rolanda, Maria
24 Rubalcava, Winston D Settrini, Sabrina E Torrales, and Jessica Wood. Also excluded from the class
25 is Lucas Danner who opted out of the Settlement.

26 4. The Court orders the Notice of Entry of this Order shall be posted by the Settlement
27 Administrator, ILYM Group, Inc., to its website at the time of the distribution of the settlement
28 payment.

1 5. The Court retains jurisdiction over the Parties with respect to all matters relating to
2 the interpretation, administration, implementation, effectuation and enforcement of this Order and
3 the Settlement.

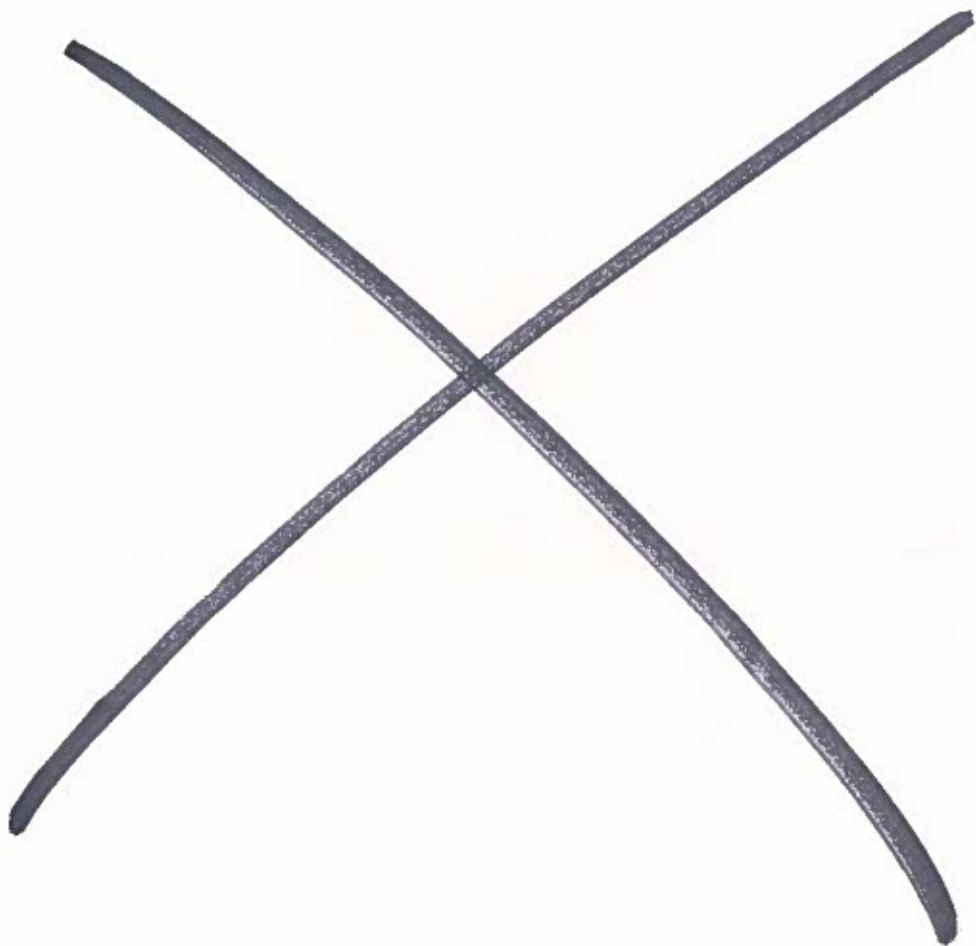
4 6. This document shall constitute a judgment for all purposes of California Rules of
