24 The Motion for Preliminary Approval of a Class Action Settlement came before this Court, on
25 August 21, 2019, Hon. Alan G. Perkins presiding. The Court having considered the papers submitted
26 in support of the application of the Parties, **HEREBY ORDERS THE FOLLOWING:**

27 1. The Court grants preliminary approval of the Settlement and the Settlement Class based
28 upon the terms set forth in the Joint Stipulation of Class Action Settlement and Release ("Settlement
Agreement"), a true and correct copy of which is attached to the Declaration of Marcus J. Bradley as



1 Exhibit "1" dated July 29, 2019. All terms used herein shall have the same meaning as defined in the
2 Settlement. The Settlement appears to be fair, adequate and reasonable to the Class.

3 2. The Settlement falls within the range of reasonableness and appears to be presumptively
4 valid, subject only to any objections that may be raised at the final fairness hearing and final approval
5 by this Court.

6 3. A final fairness hearing on the question of whether the proposed Settlement, attorneys' fees
7 and costs to Class Counsel, and the Class Representative's Service Award should be finally approved
8 as fair, reasonable and adequate as to the members of the Class is scheduled in Department 35 on the
9 date and time set forth in the implementation schedule in Paragraph 9 below.

10 4. This Court approves, as to form and content, the Notice of Pendency of Class Action
11 Settlement ("Notice"), Hearing Date for Court Approval, and Claims Procedures in substantially the
12 form attached to the Settlement as Exhibit "A" and also approves the procedure for Class Members
13 to participate in, opt out of, and object to, the Settlement as Set forth in the Settlement Agreement and
14 Notice.

15 5. The Court directs the mailing of the Notice, in accordance with the Settlement, and finds
16 the dates selected for the mailing and distribution of the mailing of the Notice Packet as set forth in
17 the Notice meet the requirements of due process and provide the best notice practicable under the
18 circumstances and shall constitute due and sufficient notice to all persons entitled thereto.

19 6. It is ordered that the Settlement Class is preliminarily certified for settlement purposes only.

20 7. The Court preliminarily confirms Plaintiff Pablo Manandeg as Class Representative, and
21 Bradley/Grombacher LLP as Class Counsel.

22 8. The Court confirms ILYM Group as the Settlement Administrator.

23 9. The Court set a Final Approval hearing for 12-11-19, at 9:15am in Department 35
24 above the above-identified courthouse.
