1 JUDGMENT

2 The Court has received and considered the motion for final approval of the Joint  
3 Stipulation of Class Action Settlement and Release of Claims (“Settlement” or “Settlement  
4 Agreement” or “Stipulation”) between Plaintiff ERASMO SANCHEZ (“Plaintiff”), on behalf of  
5 himself and all others similarly situated current and former employees, and Defendant PACIFIC  
6 SOUTHWEST CONTAINER, INC. (“Defendant”) (collectively, “the parties”). The Court  
7 entered its Order granting preliminarily approval to the Settlement on July 23, 2019, and entered  
8 its Order granting final approval of the Settlement following its final fairness and approval hearing  
9 with the parties’ counsel on November 19, 2019.

10 There were no written objections or only four requests for exclusion submitted by the  
11 Settlement Class members, and none appeared at the final fairness and approval hearing to object.  
12 There are 6,851 participating Settlement Class members, defined as: “All persons who, during the  
13 Class Period (January 23, 2014 through July 16, 2019), have previously been or currently are  
14 employed by PSC and Pacific Southwest Container, LLC, whether directly or through an  
15 employment agency or a professional services organization, in California as a non-exempt, hourly  
16 employee.” The Court has finally approved the allocations of funds from the Gross Settlement  
17 Amount, and has found the Settlement to be fair, reasonable, and adequate. Defendant and its  
18 counsel have approved the form and content of this Judgment, do not object to it, and will not  
19 contest its entry.

20 **NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:**

21 The Court having entered an order granting Final Approval of the Settlement in this action  
22 hereby enters FINAL JUDGMENT in favor of Plaintiff and the Class Members in the amount of  
23 \$2.3 million.

24 This Judgment shall bar Plaintiff and the Settlement Class members from bringing any  
25 action asserting any of the Released Claims, and Defendants and the Released Parties are hereby  
26 discharged from all Released Claims in accordance with the terms of the Settlement, including a  
27 release of all claims for wages, statutory and civil penalties, damages and liquidated damages,  
28 interest, injunctive or equitable relief, attorney’s fees and costs that were or could have been


1 alleged and whether known or unknown under the laws of California arising out of the allegations  
2 of the Complaint, during the applicable class period, and including those further claims as  
3 specified in the Settlement.

4 Without affecting the finality of this Judgment, the Court shall retain continuing  
5 jurisdiction over this action and the parties, including all Class Members and over all matters  
6 pertaining to the implementation and enforcement of the terms of the Settlement. Except as  
7 provided to the contrary herein, any disputes or controversies arising with respect to interpretation,  
8 enforcement or implementation of the Settlement shall be presented by motion to the Court for  
9 resolution.

10 This Judgment is intended to be a final disposition of the above-captioned action in its  
11 entirety and is intended to be immediately appealable. Subject to the Court's continuing  
12 jurisdiction as set forth above, the Court directs the Clerk of the Court to enter Judgment.

13 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
