**[PROPOSED] STIPULATED AMENDED
JUDGMENT OF CLASS ACTION
SETTLEMENT**

1 **STIPULATION**

2 Plaintiff Ricardo Campos Hernandez (“Plaintiff”) and Defendant Adams Iron Co., Inc.
3 (“Defendant,” and together with Plaintiff, the “Parties”), by and through their counsel of
4 record, hereby enter into a Stipulated Amended Judgment of Class Action Settlement based on
5 the following:

6 1. The Parties entered into a Joint Stipulation of Class Action Settlement that
7 resolves the claims asserted in this lawsuit on a class-wide basis;

8 2. Subject to the Court’s final approval, the settlement agreement provides that all
9 uncashed checks will be treated pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure Section 384 as a *cy pres*
10 distribution to the Legal Aid at Work. In accordance with Code of Civil Procedure Section 384,
11 the parties shall follow the procedure set for in (a) - (e) below in regard to unpaid residue:

12 (a) Unpaid residue (uncashed or returned checks) will be paid, with interest, to
13 the Legal Aid at Work, 180 Montgomery Street, Suite 600, San Francisco,
14 CA 94104;

15 (b) The attorneys for the parties shall file, with the Motion for Final Approval,
16 a stand-alone Stipulation to Amend Judgment and Proposed Stipulated
17 Amended Judgment (Section 384) memorializing the Parties’ agreement to
18 amend the judgment to adopt the administrator's determination of amount
19 of unpaid residue, plus any interest that has accrued thereon from the date
20 of entry of the initial judgment, to be paid to the *cy pres*;

21 (c) The parties shall attach to the Stipulation a [Proposed] Stipulated Amended
22 Judgment form with a signature line for the court and blanks for the
23 amount of residue plus interest to be added to the judgment and the total
24 amount of the amended judgment;

25 (d) Along with the Final Report, the administrator shall file, with the court, a
26 photocopy of the attorneys’ Stipulation to Amend Judgment along with a
27 [Proposed] Stipulated Amended Judgment form with the amount of residue
28 plus interest to be added to the judgment and the total amount of the

1 judgment, plus interest, filled in;

2 (e) The court signs and enters the Stipulated Amended Judgment.

3 3. Pursuant to those terms, the parties hereby enter into this Stipulated Amended
4 Judgment.


